



## TECHNICAL SHEET

### Plantain (Musa paradisiaca)



<b>Weight</b>	43 Lbs only fruit
<b>Cutina age:</b>	12 weeks
<b>Box Calibration:</b>	39 minimum, 46 maximum
<b>Minimum finger length:</b>	8 inches minimum
<b>Box type:</b>	22xu
<b>Leaves to harvest:</b>	Minimum six
<b>Average cluster per box:</b>	18
<b>Clusters fingers:</b>	4 minimum - 8 maximum
<b>Sanitation:</b>	2 per box maximum
<b>Cribs:</b>	2 wedges of 4 fingers without cleaning clean
<b>Shipment type:</b>	High density plastic vacuum (38*54*0.8 A/D) Low four-row packing following the pattern of small, large curved, long flat, medium and in fruit of ten inches and up make jumbo packing or three rows
<b>Label:</b>	Imperial, place 2 stamps per cluster from left to right alternately and vertically well centered



<b>Fumigation:</b>	Use of 8001 nozzle in CP3 - JACTO pump for a time of 10-12 seconds
<b>Ryzup Application:</b>	Apply directly to the crown with a brush, before applying the post-harvest mixtures (1 bottle in 20 liters of water for 1,200 boxes)

## OBLIGATIONS

- The process should not start without the presence of the evaluator
- The post-harvest mix must be prepared by the evaluator, not by farm staff
- Do not receive bunches cut the day before the cut Repackaged fruit is not accepted
- Prepare the alum the day before cutting Fruit with mealybug, scales, or field scar is not accepted
- Poorly glued or deteriorated cardboard is not accepted Treasury code must be well marked and visible on the cover
- All boxes must be vacuumed and have a good vacuum
- Give 3 (three) laps to the league
- Check that the container vents are open
- Control the CBM of the container (40 CBM)
- Do not leave boxes on the floor (double stowage)



- Place 4 reinforcements on the entire box template
- Place Filter at the beginning of the container and thermograph at the closure
- Stretch the last 4-5 wheels of the truck or container
